The Code Administrators Association of Kentucky, Office of Housing, Buildings and Construction, and Kentucky Home Builders Association, along with the cooperation of various Home Builders Associations across Kentucky, are once again pleased to announce 11 – one-day training classes are being offered across Kentucky. With the adoption of a new residential code, these one-day classes will focus on the changes that have occurred between the 2002 KRC and our new 2006 Kentucky Residential Code. It is our goal to provide you, the inspector, contractor, developer and any other construction professional involved in residential construction, with the highest quality instruction possible and the opportunity to better your understanding of the application of this new residential code.

Accompanying this letter is your registration form. Please complete all applicable line items on the registration form, select the date and location most convenient to you and return your registration form to the address identified on the form. In making your site selection, we ask that you identify an alternate site (if desired), should the site identified as your first choice be filled. **A confirmation letter, identifying the actual location and start time of the class for the site you selected, will be sent to you at the address you provide on the registration form.**

Class size is limited to the first 65 registrants; therefore, it is important to get your registration form in promptly. With these classes covering the new residential code we are anticipating the classes to fill up quickly. Those who pre-register will be provided a copy of the 2006 Kentucky Residential Code Training Manual. This 2006 KRC manual will incorporate nearly 95% of what will be in the actual 2006 KRC and thereby allow you to see first what will be in the final printed document.

This invitation is extended to any party interested in the application of the KRC, builder, developer and code enforcer. We will come to one understanding through joint training and open floor discussion and dialogue. We have elected to use but one instructor to teach all eleven classes across the state. By doing so, we know Paducah will hear the same information and explanations as the persons attending the class in Morehead. We look forward to seeing you at one of these classes.
