## **Tommy Bright SCHOLARSHIP FUND**

### **Creation of the Scholarship**

This scholarship was established to assist students achieve a more comprehensive understanding of how the United States Government operates. This will be accomplished by awarding financial aid to the scholarship recipient to attend an established governmental affairs program in Washington, D.C.

### **Value of Scholarship**

The value of the scholarship is to be \$1000.00.

### **General Scholarship Information**

- A. The scholarship shall be used for educational purposes, and is non-refundable.

The scholarship award will be made out in the name of the recipient for the specified use of an acceptable educational program.

- B. The scholarship is valid only for the current class year.
- C. The scholarship is to be awarded during the Home Builders Association of Kentucky Fall Board Meeting.
- D. Applications should be sent to the HBAK office at 1040 Burlington Lane, Frankfort, KY 40601.

### **Qualifications of the Applicant**

- A. Applicant must be presently enrolled in high school.
- B. Applicant must live in the jurisdiction of the Home Builders Association of Kentucky.
- C. Applicant must be the child or grandchild of a member or members' employee of the Home Builders Association of Kentucky.
- D. Applicant must exhibit good character.

## **Obligations of the Scholarship Recipient**

- A. Conduct her/himself in a manner that does not discredit the HBAK.
- B. To diligently pursue the completion of the chosen program toward the enhanced understanding of governmental affairs.

If all of the aforementioned qualifications have been satisfied and judged equivalent, then financial need of the applicant may be deemed a relevant factor.

## **Applying for the Scholarship**

- A. Each applicant must complete the application for the award.
- B. Each applicant must write a brief essay regarding her/his educational intentions and interest in governmental affairs.
- C. Each applicant must secure a written recommendation from two people other than family members, who can offer personal references for the applicant.
- D. Applications can be mailed or delivered to the Home Builders Association of Kentucky, 1040 Burlington Lane, Frankfort, KY 40601.

## **Selection of Scholarship Recipient**

- A. Race, creed, or sex will not be factors in the selection of the recipient.
- B. A panel of judges appointed by the scholarship committee will review the applicant's request for the scholarship.
- C. The judges will carefully check all the qualifications of the applicant in relation to personal references, recommendations and scholastic records.
- D. The judges may invite the applicant for a personal interview.
